



RUNNING START COST BREAKDOWN

Cost	Amount
Student ID Cards	\$9.00* Annual ID, valid September 1 through August 31 each year (optional).
Associated Student Fees	\$7.25* per credit, per term – This charge covers matriculation, technology and facilities fees.
Course Fees	\$30 – \$50* per course – Course fees will depend on the number of credits taken and the course types. Some courses may have slightly higher course fees.
Books	Estimated at \$75 - \$150* per book (dependent on course)*
Transportation	C-Tran Bus Pass: Free with purchase of Student ID card*. Replacement: \$48*, if lost or stolen Gas for driving (no parking permits required on campus).

****Running Start Fee Waiver:** Acceptable documentation must include the student's name and may include, but is not limited to, documents which proves any of the following:

- Proof of eligibility for free or reduced-priced lunch
- Proof that the student's family is receiving state or federal assistance funds, such as food stamps (EBT) or State medical benefits
- Proof of being a foster youth
- Proof of Social Security benefits
