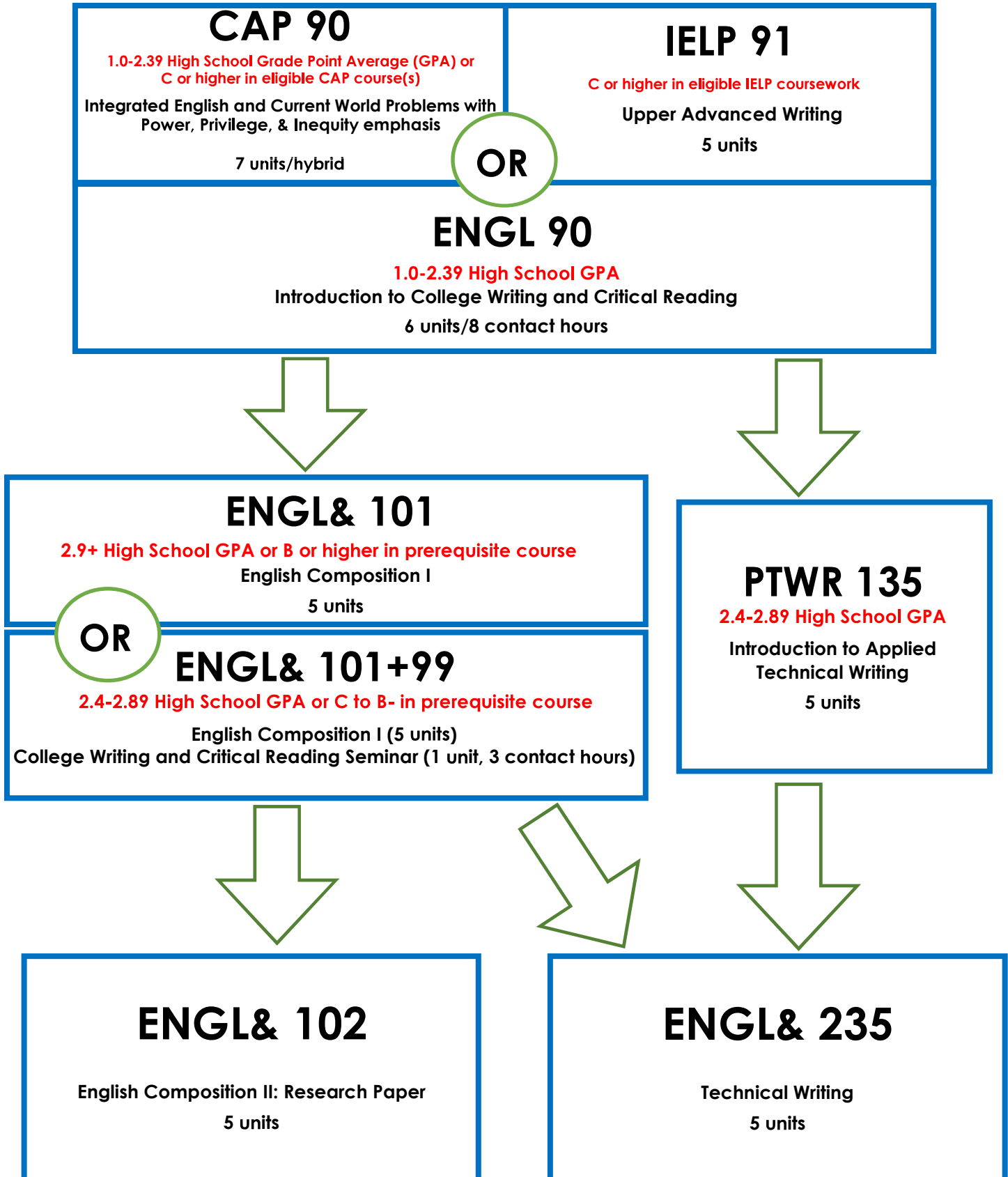


CLARK COLLEGE ENGLISH SEQUENCE

Significant emphasis on reading via Reading Apprenticeship, a method proven to increase comprehension and stamina. Students may take the course to prepare for ENGL& 101 or to complete some certificates.
